## **Shared Learning Pack Contents**


- A copy of the homework consultation feedback (this will also be shared on our social media platforms and uploaded to our website/app/Twitter)

## Information on shared learning and exemplar shared learning grids

- A jotter will be provided for all children
- Children will upload their tasks/photographs of their work to Seesaw
- A shared learning folder will be added to your child's Seesaw account
- Their work must be signed by their parent/carer, as per the shared learning contract
- Tasks will be uploaded to Seesaw by teachers on a **Monday** and responses should be uploaded by children by **Friday** at the latest
- If there is a holiday weekend, shared learning will be given out on a Tuesday and can be returned the following Monday/Tuesday (holiday depending)
- Sumdog and Reading Wise log ins will be given out and these will be part of homework tasks each week
- Grids will be uploaded by the teachers and these will outline the tasks for the week
- Feedback will be provided by teachers using text comments, voice notes and mark up tools
- We are looking into organising shared learning clubs for children and their parent/carers to attend. These dates will be confirmed soon


