For example: The cat sat on the mat. </p>	<p>Handwriting: Practice writing out the alphabet. Write each letter as a sound and the letter name. For example, A- Aa B- Bb C- Cc If you are a P2 or P3 and can join up your handwriting, write your common words using joined writing.</p>	<p>Create your own song or rap for your spelling words. Practice writing your full name out until you can write it without copying it. Include any middle names you have.</p>
