ATTENDANCE

The attendance of some children has started to become concerning.

However we are noticing that some families are going on holiday throughout the school term; holidays throughout the school term are not authorised by the Headteacher and are *labelled* as unauthorised absence. We will not provide work during these times as we expect our children to be in school.

Each school day is counted as 2 openings (AM and PM).

For families who are travelling to a home country during the school term, please provide, in writing, a letter to the Headteacher along with a photocopy of your return flight details.



School starts at 9am.

Children who arrive 10 or 15 minutes late each day miss around 1 hour of core teaching each week; this is 39 hours per school year! Please teach your child to be punctual for school.
