



Class Learning Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

Languages

This term we will be focusing on phonological awareness and the children will be building up their knowledge of syllables, rhyme and initial sounds. The children will be continuing to focus on the story 'Elmer' and will also be looking at other nursery rhymes and stories. We will also be reading a class novel together.

Numeracy and Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on grouping, sorting and ordering items. We will also focus on number formation and number recognition to ten. The children will look at numbers before and after and be able to order numbers to ten. The children will also look at patterns which will link to our story 'Elmer'.

Religious Education

This term the children will be focusing on learning their daily prayers and the sign of the cross. We will also look at what makes us special and our similarities and differences.

Health and Wellbeing

This term the children will be getting used to life in our school. We will explore values and in particular, our school values of friendship, honesty, learning and respect.

Social Subjects

Our whole school focus this term is 'All about Me'. The children will be learning about what they like and dislike. They will be learning about their own particular interests and how these differ to their friends and other children in the class.

Sciences

The children will be learning about their five senses - smell, sight, hear, touch and taste. They will also be learning about the changes a caterpillar goes through to become a butterfly.

Expressive Arts

This term the children will be exploring using different media to create pictures and paintings. They will create art pieces linked to our topics 'All about Me' and 'Elmer'.

Information and Communications Technology

We will have opportunities to explore various educational and interactive games on the smart board. We will also be introducing the children to the Learning Zone which has a range of technologies including computers.

Homework

The children will receive a wordless reading book every week. As much as possible, you should be trying to read with them every night. They will also get a home learning grid linked to phonological awareness tasks. Please complete some of these tasks each week with them.
