



# Class Learning Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

## Languages

In reading Primary 5 will be finding reliable sources, finding and selecting information based on their topic, The Romans and then using their found information to create new pieces of non-fiction texts. Pupils will also continue with their core readers.

Primary 5 will also be learning French this year, focussing on greetings, asking simple questions e.g. what is your name? Colours, days of the week, months of the year and describing the weather.

## Numeracy and Mathematics

In maths we will be focussing on rounding and estimation with whole numbers and decimal fractions. Exploring the link between decimal fractions, percentages fractions. Pupils will learn how to find the fraction or percentage of a quantity. Primary 5 will also be continuing their number processes, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

## Religious Education

In R.E. pupils will be exploring themes of  
-the Holy Spirit and how Jesus had different roles.  
-how we can recognise when we are being called to follow Jesus e.g. putting others before ourselves.  
-Christian origin in Scotland.  
-our own talents and gifts that God gave us.

## Health and Wellbeing

During P.E. Primary 5 will be focussing on netball for indoors and ball skills/games outdoors, whilst improving our skills we will be working as part of a team and understanding how to be a good team mate.  
This term Primary 5 will also be involved in the Great Scottish Run at Glasgow Green!  
In class, we will be looking at our rights and how we can ensure we are respecting other people's rights.

## Social Subjects

This term we will be learning about the Romans! From who they were, what they did, what they wore to inventions!

Topic will link up to literacy and researching facts and finding reliable sources.

## Sciences

In science, pupils will be learning all about  
-their organ systems  
-digestive, respiratory and circulatory systems  
-and the structure of the ear and eye.

## Expressive Arts

Pupils will be taking part in art which will link to their topic, exploring Roman art, in particular, mosaics.

## Information and Communications Technology

Pupils will be using technology to find some reliable sources for their literacy work. They will learn how to ensure a website is safe and if the information can be trusted. WE will also be using the computer to create new pieces of text and enhancing it with graphics to make it more interesting for the reader. Pupils will also be making power points to present their findings to the rest of the class.

## Homework

Homework will comprise of literacy activities, maths and a topic related piece.
