

Hassleaming Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

<u>Languages</u>

During reading Primary 5 will be learning how to use punctuation, grammar and layout to alter their fluency and expression when reading aloud. We will also be working on answering different types of questions - literal, inferential and evaluative, knowing the difference between each. In writing, we will be spending time on setting and characterisation. In Grammar, we will be learning about grammatical agreement of plural nouns; synonyms; concrete and abstract nouns; possessive singular nouns and present participles as adjectives. These skills will help your child to uplevel their writing to ensure it makes sense and interests the reader.

We will be continuing our French too, moving on to our family and classroom objects.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In maths, we will be focussing on our multiplication and division, ensuring that we are confident in each of these number processes which will help when we come back to fractions and percentages later in the year.

This term we will also be looking at time. Ensuring that we can tell the time to one minute exactly, converting between 12- and 24-hour time, reading calendars and timetables and beginning to make links between speed, distance and time.

Religious Education

During R.E. we will be looking at Saints lives and what makes a Saint, what we can do to help those who are less fortunate than ourselves and why we should treat people the way that we would want to be treated. In December, we will be focussing on Advent and the Nativity.

Health and Wellbeing

During indoor P.E. we will be focussing on badminton, developing our skills and understanding all rules and ensuring that we can fully take part in a game either singles or doubles. During outdoor P.E. we will be focussing on increasing our overall fitness levels as we take part and create various courses to work different parts of our bodies.

Social Subjects

This term, we will be comparing the lifestyle and culture of citizens in other countries with our own in Scotland, discussing similarities and differences in our celebrations and festivals. We will also be discussing the environmental impact of human activity and suggest ways in which we can live in a more environmentally responsible way.

Sciences

In science, we will be following on from the structure of the ear and eye and looking at vibrations and waves and how sound and light travels through air and various materials.

Expressive Arts

As we learn about the impact humans have on the environment, we will be looking at artists who use recycled materials to create art. We will then have a chance to do these ourselves, communicating or thoughts and ideas. In December we will take part in various Christmas related art activities.

Information and Communications Technology

This term, our technology will link up with our Social Studies as we continue to look at how lifestyle can impact on the environment and the Earth's resources e.g. mobile phones. Looking at the materials that are needed to create a mobile phone and then what happens when a person buys a new one.

Homework

Homework will comprise of literacy activities involving spelling and reading, maths and topic related work.
