



Class Learning Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

Languages

This term we will continue to build on our knowledge of initial sounds and blends made by a combination of letters. The children will continue to blend two or more sounds together which will allow them to read more words. We will also introduce more tricky and common words every day. We will focus on using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces when completing our written pieces.

This term we will read a variety of fiction and non-fiction books from our school library.

Numeracy and Mathematics

This term we will be continuing to focus on the concept of addition and look our number stories to ten. We will be introducing time and the children will look at the differences between analogue and digital time and also be able to read o'clock and half past.

Religious Education

This term the children will be focusing on showing love for others, God's Love for me and the story of Creation. We will also focus on lent and Easter during the month of March.

Health and Wellbeing

This term the children will continue to use the PATHS programme to explore different emotions. They will develop skills on how to cope in challenging times and learn about building positive relationships with each other. They will be focusing on gymnastics skills during their indoor PE time and athletics outdoor.

Social Subjects

The children have decided they would like to learn more about France. We will look into French culture, language, food, cities and the weather. We will also compare France to Scotland and look at the similarities and differences between the two countries.

Sciences

The children will be learning through creative play about different materials. They will also learn how to stay safe when using electricity.

Expressive Arts

In art they will be looking at different artists and designers work, and will be able to discuss these pieces of work with each other. They will continue the YMI music programme learning about rhythm and beat and being able to use their voices and musical instruments in different scenarios.

Information and Communications Technology

We will continue to use our classroom iPads and learning zone to explore different educational games and computer programmes. The children will learn about how to stay safe when using the internet.

Homework

The children will continue to have homework tasks each night. They will also be given a new reading book each Monday. Please make sure you read their home reader every night with them.
