



Class Learning Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

Languages

This term in literacy our focus will be:

Writing

- Creative writing and using descriptive language to write short stories.
- Persuasive writing texts
- Using ambitious vocabulary in writing
- Using connectives to extend writing.

Spelling and grammar

- Using spelling pathways to explore vowel sounds, prefixes and suffixes.
- Developing sight vocabulary
- Developing confidence in using punctuation.
- Revising grammar rules and sentence parsing

Reading

- Class novel - 'Charlotte's web' (extended from term 3)
- Weekly group/paired reading sessions
- Opportunities for independent reading
- Focus on developing understanding of reading materials (comprehension)

Numeracy and Mathematics

This term in numeracy the focus will be:

Numeracy

- Developing confidence in the 3 and 4 times table (extending to the 7 and 8 times table)
- Developing understanding of long and short multiplication and division.
- Developing strategies for addition and subtraction quickly and accurately.

Maths

- Money-coin value, coin recognition, counting change, paying for goods, spotting shopping deals.
- Understanding of decimal numbers.
- Exploring basic algebraic equations.

Religious Education

- The ways in which we show care for the world and for the needs of all people.
- Understanding positive things about friendships and relationships and how to seek help when worried or upset.
- Preparation for First Holy Communion

Health and Wellbeing

In health and wellbeing we will focus on:

- My self-identity
- My rights
- Weekly P.E sessions
- Healthy habits

Social Subjects

In social subjects we will focus on:

- 'Life on a farm' - exploring the modern farm and from 'farm to fork'
- Where our food comes from
- Opportunities for STEM based activities
- Opportunities for research and class presentations
- Links to class novel

Sciences

In science we will focus:

- Inheritance- What makes us?
- Exploring features/personalities that may be inherited.
- Genetic information and how genetics are passed
