

Hasslerning Information

We hope you find this information helpful. This is just some of what your child is learning in class this Term!

Languages

This term, we will continue using our core reading books and developing on our skills from term 1 and 2, using skimming and scanning, taking notes and using various reading strategies to help find and understand information. Children will then use this information to write information reports and articles. Pupils will take part in daily discussions and will also take part in a solo talk this term about a natural disaster event that they have researched. As always, we will continue with our spelling and grammar.

In French we will be learning about the weather and classroom commands.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In maths, we will be exploring angles in our environment, classifying angles, drawing and measuring accurate angles and finding angles within a triangle. We will also be working on our problem solving skills and how to use more than one strategy or calculation for a problem. We will also revisit fractions, developing our previous knowledge and exploring equivalent.

Religious Education

In R.E. we will be learning about the Ten Commandments and the significance of them. We will also be looking at the Old Testament and in particular Genesis and the Prophets and Kings. Children will also be able to look up passages from the bible.

Health and Wellbeing

During term 3, primary 5 will be looking at the theme Resilience. First looking at ourselves and how we cope with daily changes and things that might not go our way and how we can be hopeful, positive and build resilience from this. We will be continuing our P.E. outdoors on Tuesdays learning about football, developing our skills and being able to work as part of a team and on Wednesday's indoors we will be learning how to play tennis.

Social Subjects

This term the class have chosen to learn about Natural Disasters. We will be exploring through literacy and technology what happens before, during and after a natural disaster. Children will find out about volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis, bushfires and flooding.

Sciences

In science, pupils will be learning about forces, learning about friction, gravity and push and pull factors. Pupils will experiment with different weights and objects.

Expressive Arts

This term, pupils will take part in various drama activities related to our topic. Pupils will develop short scripts as news presenters to give information that they have learned. Pupils will also use the IPads to create music introductions to their news report. Pupils will also take part in art activities relating to their topic.
