When does School start back?

All children will attend for 2 days on Wednesday 12th and Thursday 13th August (Primary 1 9.15 - 12.15pm).

A full school return for everyone from Monday 17th August.

When will my child be in School?

From Monday 17th August, school hours are:

Primary 1; 8.45am - 2.45pm Primary 2 - 7; 9am - 3pm

Will the breakfast club be open?

Yes, the breakfast club will still be open; you will need to pay in advance online. We can give you the details upon request.

What about Free School Meals?

All children in Primary 1 - 4 are entitled to a Free School Meal, as well as children who meet the free meal criteria.

Children who pay for lunch will be asked to do so using an online payment method. Details available on request.

Can my child bring a packed lunch?

Yes, all children are still allowed to bring a packed lunch.

Can parents come into School?

So that everyone can stay safe we ask that you do not come into the playground (except Primary 1 and 2 at end of day) or school building unplanned. We welcome phone calls and emails, and will get back to you as soon as we can. Drop off and pick up of children will be at assigned gates.

Primary 1 and 2 at infant gate opposite Church.

Primary 3, 4 and 5 at Nursery gate

Primary 6 and 7 at gate at former janitor house

Staff will also be outside to help.

When collecting P1 and P2 children please stand behind the rainbow line and on a social distance marker. This will help protect everyone.

Should children wear a Uniform?

Yes, but your child will NOT need indoor shoes or a school bag. They may bring a packed lunch bag with their lunch or snack inside.

Is PE (physical education) on?

Yes, at the moment all PE will take place outdoors. Children do not need to bring a kit at this time.

We will continue to use Showbie (this is not new)!

Showbie is our online learning platform which will be used for homework and if we need to close suddenly. All children will be given a class code. More information to follow.
