**Uniform List**

Please find below details of the uniform your child will require for attending St. Mungo's Primary School, as well as information about our uniform supplier *Be Schoolwear*.

Cardigan or Jumper edged with school colours

Sky blue shirt worn with school tie

Navy trousers, skirt or pinafore

Black Shoes with Navy Socks or Tights

Black Pimsoils for Indoors

St. Mungo's School Tie

Black Outdoor Shoes

Children should wear a t-shirt and shorts or leggings for PE with trainers or soft shoes.

Children should wear a shirt and tie to school. This will help them develop specific skills including fine motor skills and will allow them to identify as part of the School family.

Trousers, skirts etc should be navy blue.

## Car Park:
