- The assessment will be a range of practical, group and individual written tasks and is assessed through the submission of a portfolio of evidence accumulated throughout the year.
- This will be assessed internally and the evidence submitted counts for 100% of the final grade decision.
- This is graded on a Pass/ Fail basis.

National 5 Skills for Work: Early Learning and Childcare is an introductory qualification that develops the skills, knowledge, and attitudes needed for work in the early learning and childcare sector.

At National 5, candidates begin to prepare for working in the sector and develop transferable employability skills.

This qualification covers the following areas:


