## **Attendance**

This month, I can provide the following update on our school's attendance statistics:

October's attendance rate (Whole School) - 89.9% November's attendance rate (Whole School) - 89.7%

The number of pupil's with 10% or more absence rate, which is equivalent to missing 4 weeks of school:

October - 127 pupils

November—130 pupils

As you can see, both of these figures have declined since last month and are of concern. Please continue to ensure your child/ren attend school everyday.
