### Family Calendar

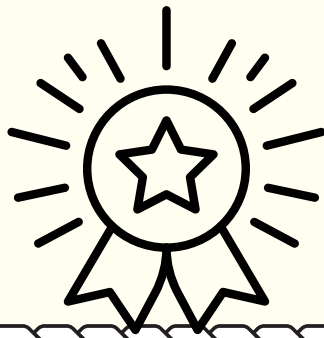
