CURRICULAR INFORMATION

LITERACY

- This term we are focusing on character descriptions. We will look at a model text and use it to create our own pieces of writing.
- Throughout this term we will be engaging in a novel study. We will be exploring Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl and complete tasks to gain a better understanding of the text in class.
- In talking and listening this term we will be preparing for our class assembly. We
 will focus on building confidence, speaking clearly and working as a group to
 deliver a successful presentation.

NUMERACY AND MATHS

- Within numeracy this term, we will be exploring fractions. We will be focusing on ordering, comparing, finding equivalent fractions and adding equal fractions.
- This term we will also cover measurement. We will be exploring length, mass, area and volume through estimation, correct measurement and converting various units of measure.
- Later in the term, we will look at chance and uncertainty to understand probability through data interpretation and predicting.

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIAL STUDIES

- Our IDL topic this term is 'Lifecycles', we will be learning about how plants and animals grow and develop at different stages of their lives. We will also explore how factors like climate, nutrition and inheritance can affect their development.
- Through our topic, we will be exploring science, technology, social studies, maths and literacy.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

- Primary 4 will be continuing with their learning within the PAThS programme (Promoting Alternative Thinking Strategies). This will encourage discussion surrounding feelings and emotions. We will focus on making good choices, managing emotions and conflict resolution.
- This term, P4 will be learning and performing a routine linked to IDL in dance coaching.
- They will also participate in tag rugby, this will include developing skills in teamwork, stamina and co-ordination.
