LITERACY

- This term we are focusing on explanation texts and character descriptions. We will look
 at a model text for each and use these to create our own pieces of writing.
- Throughout this term we will be engaging in a novel study. We will be exploring the Butterfly Lion by Michael Morpurgo. Each week your child will be given a chapter of the book to read as part of their homework. We will then complete tasks to gain a better understanding of the text in class.
- In talking and listening this term we will be focusing on solo talks and the skills needed to give a successful presentation.
- In French, we will be learning about the topics School and Shops.



NUMERACY AND MATHS

- We are currently learning about information handling. We will be learning to read different types of graphs. We will also be completing our own surveys and using the information to create our own graphs.
- Within numeracy this term, we will be exploring decimal numbers and money. We will
 be focusing on money calculations, budgeting, understanding the difference between
 needs and wants and, profit and loss. When you are out and about, encourage your
 child to pay for things or discuss costs with them.
- Later in the term we will be exploring measure. We will be exploring length, ma perimeter, area and volume.

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIAL STUDIES

- Our IDL topic this term is 'Biodiversity', we will be learning about different living things, ecosystems and habitats. We will be learning about plants and what they need to survive.
- Through our topic we will be exploring science, technology, social studies, maths and literacy. We will also be looking at the Global Goals and Global Citizenship and how it relates to us.
