- Leavers hoodies for all Primary 7 pupils

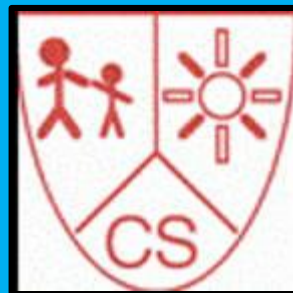
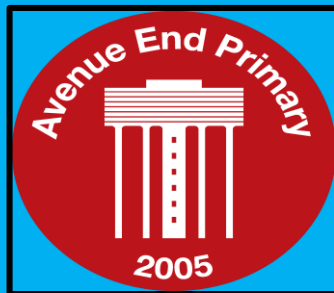
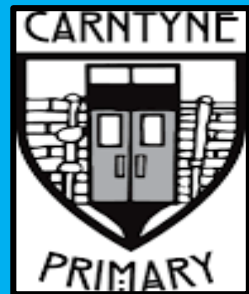


LEARNING COMMUNITY CHALLENGES & MISSIONS 2023-24
