Science / Social Subjects

Our interdisciplinary learning (**IDL**) theme for this term is:

1. Space and the solar system . 2. Film literacy and photography

We will be studying:

1. Explore space and the solar system, using the childrens interest to direct learning. Begin by exploring planets, phases of the moon and relate to current world events such as Artemis II. 2. Explore how *Lava* tells a story through music, visuals, and character emotions. Identify key themes, and respond by sharing ideas and creating their own related work, further exploring film features such as camera angles and lighting, before moving onto photography skills.
