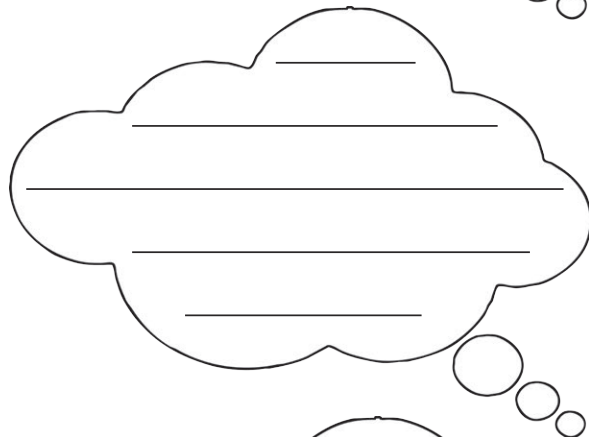
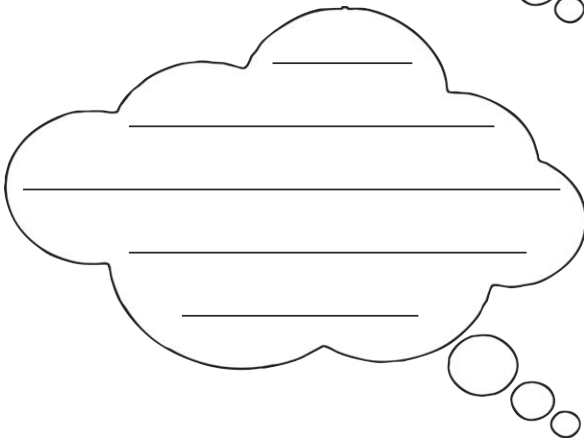
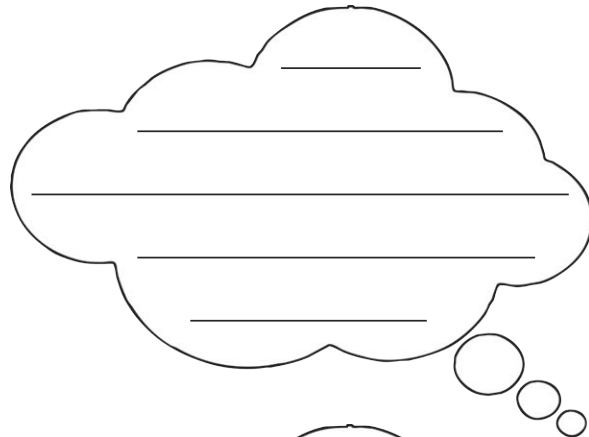
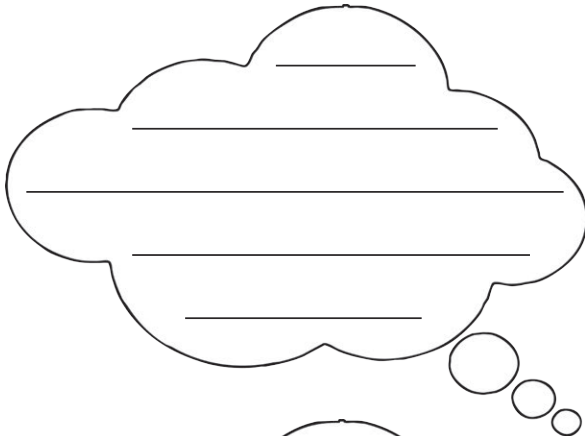
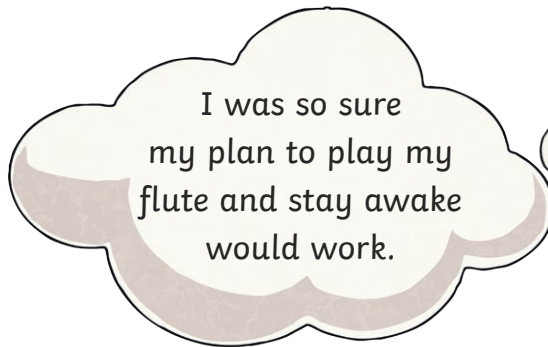
Part A

Use your knowledge of the story to help you write from the point of view of Vasily.

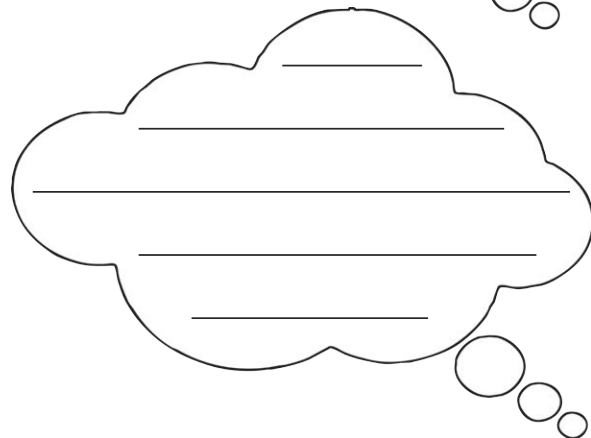
Can you imagine how Vasily felt the next day when he was woken by his father, having failed to catch the thief?
