Answers

1. The heart was not removed during mummification.
2. Hathor was the goddess of love, music and dance.
3. Four canopic jars were placed in the tomb with the mummy.
4. In the hall of the dead, Anubis weighed your heart.
5. Natron was used to dry up moisture from the body as it was mummified.
6. Tutankhamun's tomb was found in 1922 by Howard Carter.
7. The people who wrote the hieroglyphs were called scribes.
8. Over 130 pyramids have been found in Egypt.
9. Tutankhamun was 18 years old when he died.
10. Ramses II reigned for 66 years.
11. Ra, Horus and Thoth are shown with the heads of birds.
12. Hieroglyphs were made up of pictures and symbols rather than letters.
13. The Nile provided people with fertile soil, water, food and transport.
14. A shaduf is a tool for lifting water from the canals. It is a long pole balanced on a beam, with a weight on one end and a bucket on the other.
15. Egyptians used a reed called papyrus for making an early kind of paper.
16. The Great Pyramid was over 140 metres high when it was built.



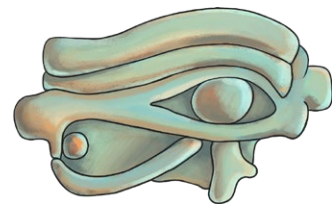
