

Ancient Egypt Triarama



Carefully cut out the square provided.



Fold the square along a diagonal line to make a triangle. Now fold the triangle in half again to make a smaller triangle.



Next, open the paper back up into a square and cut **only** along the solid line.



Finally, overlap section A and B and stick.

Now you have made your triarama, you are ready to create your own 3D illustration!

You can use your model to illustrate a story, character, place or event. Draw a background on your model, add text such as poems or facts and add cut-out objects or characters to the foreground of your model. You can even group four triaramas together to make a more detailed model.

Use some of the illustrations below to include in your 3D triarama. If you are using them for your background, cut off the bottom tabs. For images in the foreground of your model, cut and fold tab backwards and glue into place on the base of your model.
