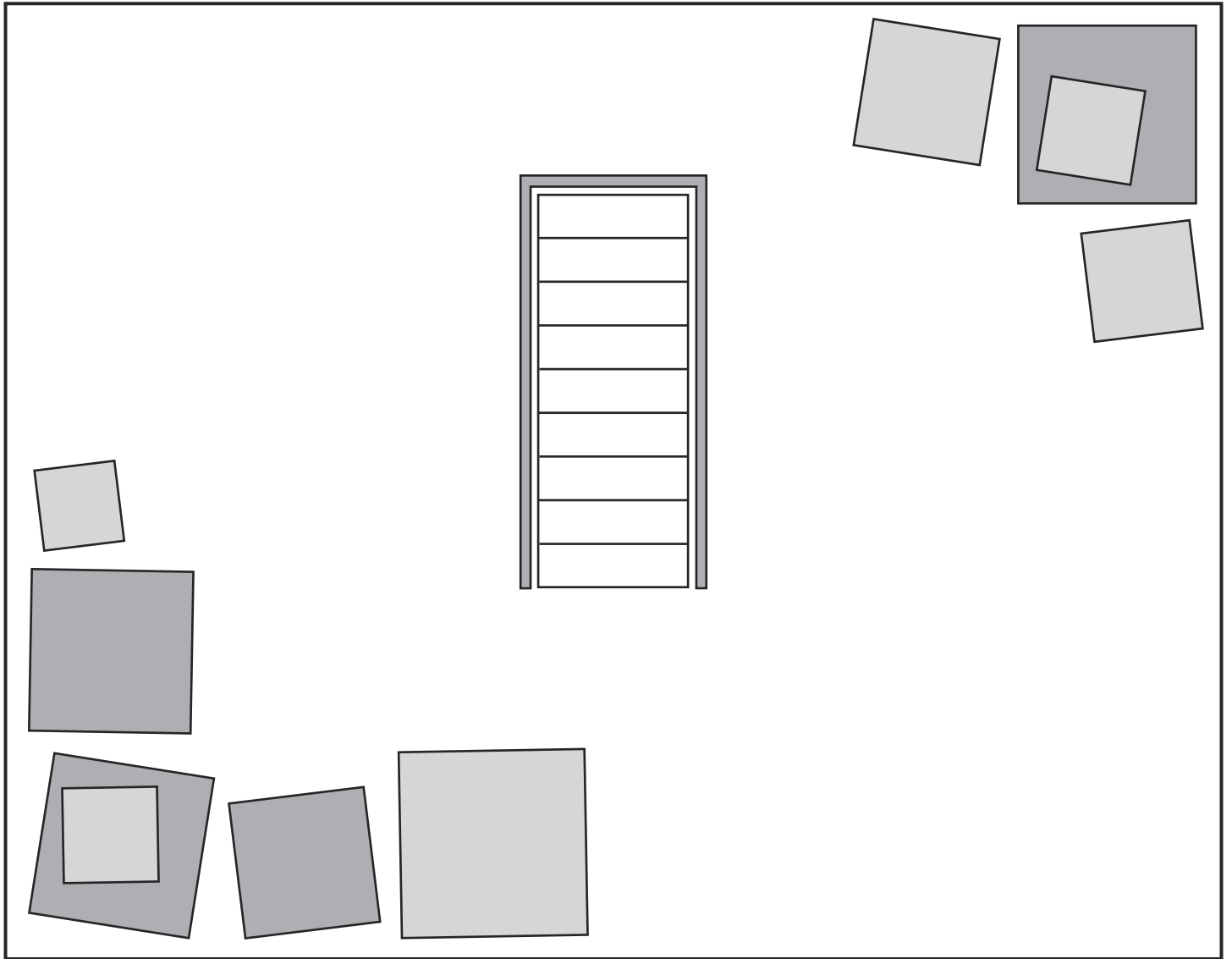
Part A
