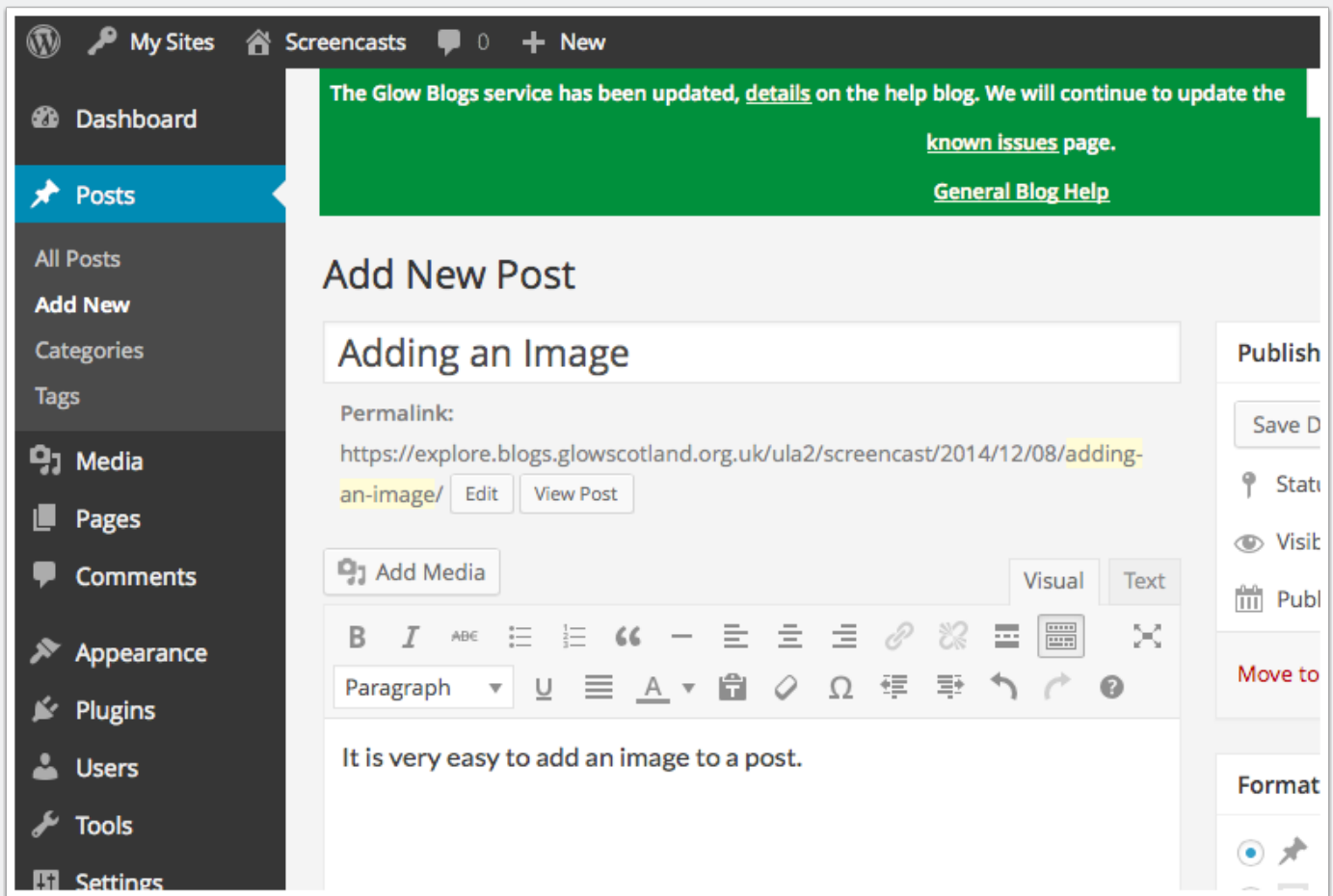


Adding an image to a post

Create a post

1. In the dashboard click Add New to create a new post.
2. Give your post a title.
3. Place the I-bar in the body field where you want the image. (*This could be between text*)
4. Click the **Add Media** button.

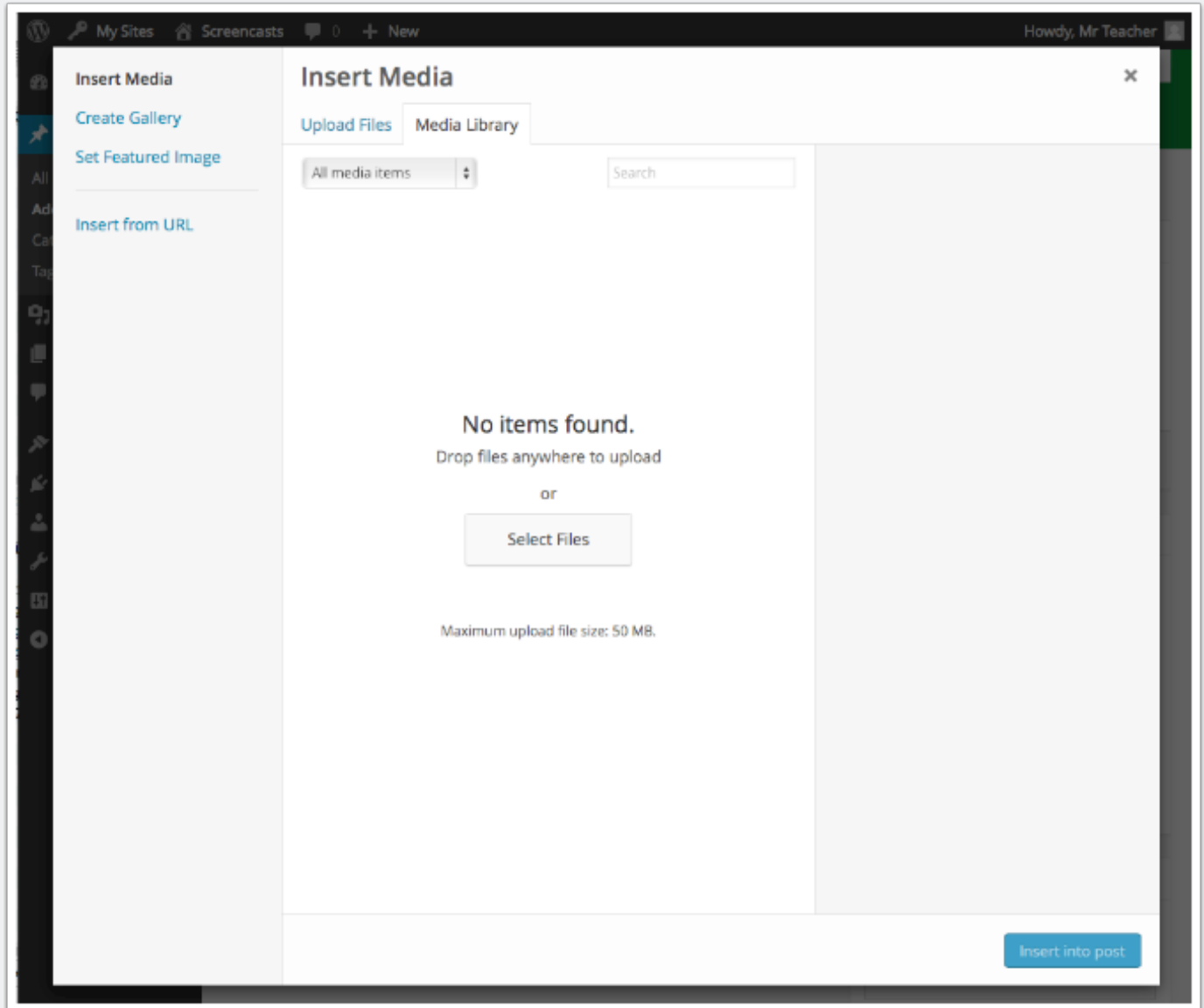


Select the image

A 'lightbox' window open up

Click Select Files (or drag on some images)

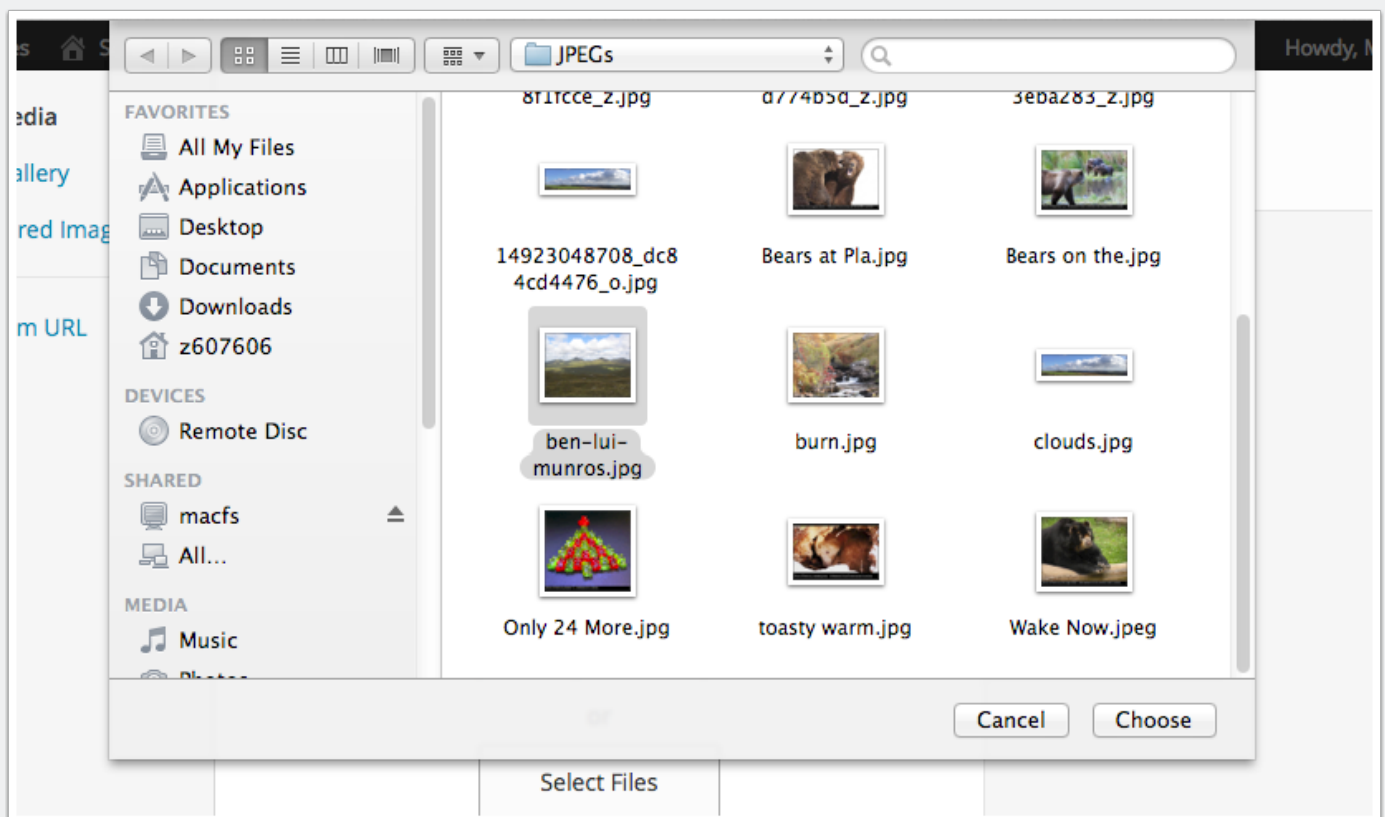


Adding an image to a post

Select file(s) to upload

In the file dialog that opens

1. Choose an image
2. Click Choose (or Open depending on browser)



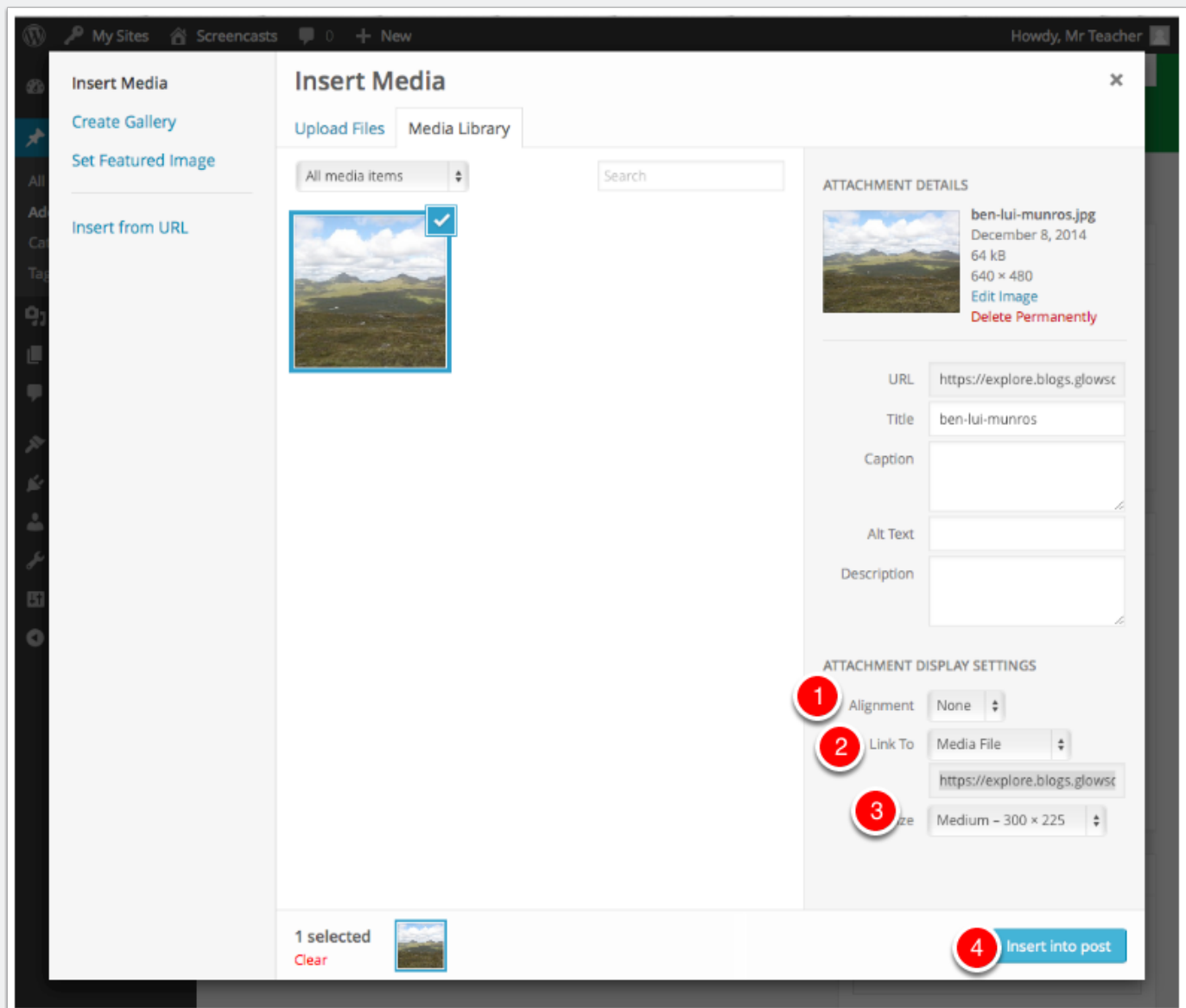
Adding an image to a post

Image settings

The uploaded images will be selected (the tick). You can change the alignment **[1]**, the link for visitors clicking on the image **[2]** and the size of the image **[3]**, before clicking insert **[4]**.

*If you are using the lightbox plugin to show larger versions of the image without leaving the page set **Link To** to **Media File**.*

Finish the post

The image is inserted into the post editor. You can click on the image, as in the screenshot to see the x to delete or the pencil to edit the image settings.
