Taking our cue from the requirements of the SQA Music Curriculum for Excellence, we are dividing Maestro Music into 3 distinct parts:

Explore

Get inside the music of FIVE through the RSNO's online resources devised for pupils in S4-S6. From September 2011 there will be a chance to explore the repertoire in the classroom through a series of PowerPoint presentations and video clips featuring RSNO musicians.

The resources will draw on all aspects of the lives of the composers who created these dramatic works, and the impact their music had on the world around them. Topics will include nationalism, censorship and social justice and will be relevant for students also studying history, language and social studies.

Scotland's world-class national orchestra will perform this programme of fascinating music, enhanced by Paul Rissmann's superb presentations.
