Teachers will work with different art forms, including poetry, visual arts, drama, storytelling, dance or music. At the end of the day each participant receives a 120 page resource book that can be used in the classroom.

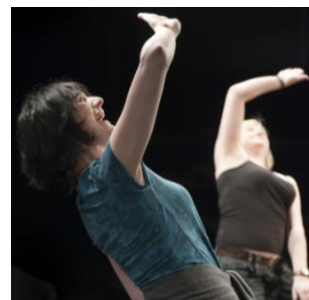
Teachers will work with professional drama and dance practitioners from Citizens Theatre and Scottish Ballet.
