The opportunity is free but you must be available to spend two full days at the home of the RSNO in Glasgow on 15 & 16 June 2015.

Closing date for applications is Wednesday 1 October 2014. Successful applicants will then be invited to attend an interview in Glasgow on Sunday 5 October.

We're looking for talented individuals to perform in the foyers of Scotland's concert halls before RSNO Season concerts. Anyone aged 12–21 is invited to apply but you should be able to perform to a high standard (equivalent to ABRSM Grade 7 or higher).

To apply, please send us a video of yourself playing 15–20 minutes of music. Open to individuals and groups (maximum of five players in a group). All performances must be acoustic and music must be classical in genre. Applicants are welcome to perform their own compositions. All musicians, including singers, are welcome to apply. You should have at least 30 minutes worth of repertoire.
