RELAXED PERFORMANCE

Our relaxed performance is inclusive to all and is designed to support audiences with a range of needs: children, young people and adults with autism, sensory and communication impairments and learning disabilities.

- Sound levels will be lowered and lighting changes on stage will be reduced (there will be no strobe lighting).
- Audience lighting will remain on throughout the concert.
- Audience members will be free to come and go from the auditorium at any point throughout the performance.
- There will be a designated quiet space accessible before, during and after the concert.
- A BSL interpreter will be made available for the concert if requested in advance.
- Audience will have access to the auditorium 30 minutes before the start of the concert.
