# What will you investigate?

Partnership Grants of up to £3,000 are available to enable students, aged 5 – 18, to carry out projects in science, mathematics, computing, data science, technology or engineering.

The project must be investigative and supported by a teacher and a STEM professional (research or industry) in partnership.

## Process and timeline

### February

#### Stage 1 of application process opens

Submit your interest and provide initial details about your project.

### March

#### Stage 1 closes beginning of March

Eligibility checks carried out and successful applications progressed to Stage 2 where further project details are required.

#### Stage 2 closes end of March

### April – July

Judging process and decisions by Partnership Grants Panel.

### July

Results announced and successful applicants notified.

### July – October

Administration and start of projects.
