Welcome back! We hope that everybody had a good break and that everyone is ready and raring to go for the year ahead.

#### Charity Collection

Many thanks for your generosity on our Christmas Clothing Day. We raised £152.12 for Cash for Kids.

#### Names on Clothing

We would like to remind parents/carers to ensure that all items of clothing, including indoor shoes, are labelled with your child's name. There are a huge amount of unclaimed red jumpers and black plimsoll shoes in the school at the moment. It is extremely difficult to reunite children with lost property when there is no name on it especially as there are over 400 children on the campus.

#### School Bus

Children who use the school bus must abide by the rules set out by the council and the school. Children must remember to remain seated and to keep their seatbelt on at all times. Also they must be careful not to distract the driver or to annoy or upset other children on the bus. If the driver is unhappy with behaviour on the bus then this will be reported to the school. The council's policy is that children who misbehave on the bus or break the rules will only be given three chances otherwise they will lose their seat on the bus. We would appreciate it if parents/carers could support the school in reminding children of the correct behaviour on the school bus. We do revisit this issue frequently at Assemblies.

#### Scottish Culture Days

On Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> and Friday 25<sup>th</sup> January pupils from both schools will again be participating in our Scottish Culture Days. Over the two days pupils will participate in a range of activities with a Scottish theme, including dancing, art, cooking and singing. On the Friday afternoon both schools will come together for a whole campus ceilidh where they will dance and perform songs together.

#### Clubs

We have a variety of clubs running this term including: football, fun games, multisports, rugby and cheerleading (lunchtime). We also have some coaches, provided by Active Schools, in to deliver Dance and Football during curricular time.

#### PE Kit

It has come to our attention that not all pupils are bringing PE kits to school. Please remember that your child's PE kit should be shorts and a t-shirt which they should bring on their allocated PE days (these may change across the year and class teachers will notify you of this). Some pupils are bringing crop top type items to school for PE days, this is not appropriate clothing for PE. There will be occasions where PE takes place outdoors. Please also remember that, in line with council policy, children are not permitted to wear football colours for PE and they should also wear appropriate sports shoes. If they do not have appropriate footwear for PE then they may be unable to take part for safety reasons. We would appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that children come to school appropriately prepared for PE lessons.

#### Engine Idling – When You Stop Turn It Off

We are very grateful to the team of volunteers who worked so hard to build the planters to help create the living wall along the fence of the pitch on St. Andrew's Road. This living screen will act as a filter between our pupils and the traffic fumes from the vehicles on the road as research has shown the negative impact that traffic fumes can have on children's health. With that in mind we have noticed that at drop off and pick up times around the school many vehicles are sitting waiting with their engines still running. This obviously has a detrimental impact on the air quality around the school. The Eco Committee from the campus are planning to undertake air quality sampling this year and these results will be shared with everyone. We kindly ask that you consider the health and wellbeing of our children and families and follow the advice When You Stop Turn It Off. Engine idling is also reportable within Glasgow City Council and fixed penalty notices can be issued. If you want to report an engine idling offence, please contact 0141 287 1059 (press option 3).
