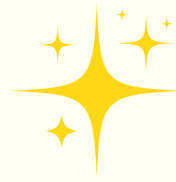

What makes this achievement even more remarkable is Jude only joined the team in August and has been a standout star since day one. Well done, Jude—we're all so proud of you!



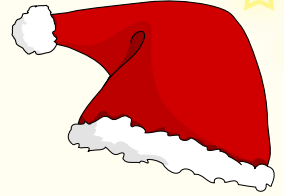

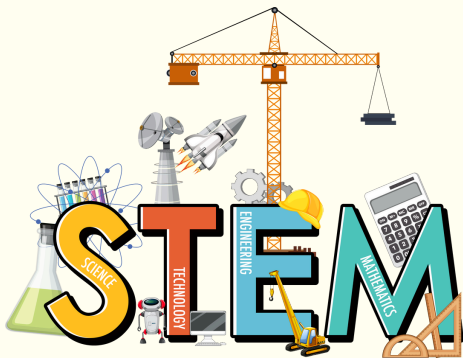
We are suggesting a £5 entry fee as a donation, and payment will be collected on the night.
