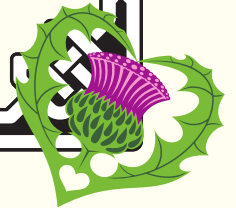

On the day, we raised an incredible £1,998.23! After deducting expenses such as venue costs and purchases to make the event a success, the final total stands at £1,553.38.

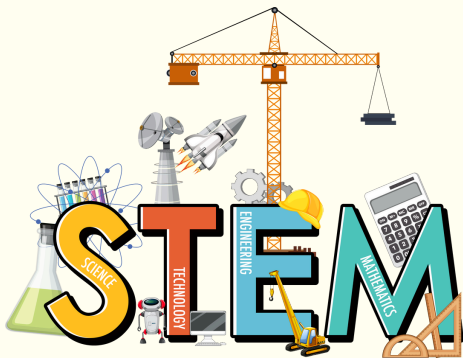
School Disco:
