


What to do









Cut a strip of paper long enough to fit round your wrist. Fasten to your wrist [you might need some help] with tape.






Attach more sticky tape around the paper so that items can be attached [double-sided tape works well].










As you walk in the garden, street or park collect leaves and petals in as many colours as you can.





Stick onto your wrist band to make a colourful bracelet.








The Sleeping Miser

You will need





















The blindfolded person [Miser] sits in the middle of the circle guarding the treasure. The other children [stalkers] form a ring around the Miser.
