






Visiting Family in Phase 1

Josh and Jane have been home learning using activities their teachers have sent them.














They are really excited that the new guidance means they will get to see some of their family that they have only seen on video calls.





Mum and Dad had called Granny Annie on Thursday night and she told them not to worry, because Auntie Fay and Paul would be visiting them anyway.












Dad brought a picnic basket with food, water, plates and cutlery because they cannot use these items from another household.

On Sunday, they decided to stay home because they were getting visitors.












Uncle Steve, Aunt Gina, Mark and Pheebs were coming to play in their garden.












Aunt Gina went to give Mum a hug, but Jane reminded them of the 2 metres rule.
