





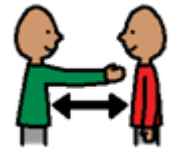




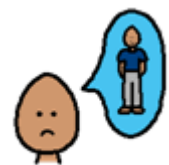
# Questions
