
Being autistic does not change the fact that people need other people. Some people need lots of friends. Other people need a few close friends. This is true for autistic people too.





# Autistic people lack empathy.




There is a difference in how the brain processes information. This means that how information is communicated may need to be changed to be appropriately processed. Autism is not a learning disability.









