The UK is split into areas called Constituencies.



There are 650 constituencies in the UK.



A Political Party wins if they have 326 MPs elected.



This is called an Overall Majority.



In each constituency, people vote at polling stations.




The votes for each constituency is counted.



If no party wins an Overall Majority, it is called a Hung Parliament.





They win a seat in the House of Commons.



A Coalition Governemt can be formed by two parties joining so the have 326 elected MPs between them.



The Prime Minister is usually the leader of the winning Political Party.





the most votes becomes the MP for that constituency



A Minority Government can be made if other parties agree to support the bigger party.
