The project leads are working through a four-phase plan and are currently working across Phase 3 and 4.

- Phase 1 Understanding the landscape.
- Phase 2 Reflection & analysis.
- Phase 3 Seeking to identify areas for national support and development, as well as opportunities for key messaging and supporting partners to implement these.
- <u>Phase 4</u> Agreeing SLC system recommendations to support children's early SLC and the development of a SLC Action Plan for Scotland.

Children and Families Continued connection with partners delivering family support offers including PEEP, Parent Club, Bookbug, Smart Play Network. Development of a plan for parental engagement to inform content of SLC Action Plan.

A Focus on Prevention Publication of an <u>evidence paper</u> to help leaders, and practitioners better understand preventable SLC and advocate for primary and secondary prevention approaches.

Collaboration The National Network for Early Language and Communication continues with network sessions in March and June 2025. NELC contributions to the updated Health Visitor Action Plan

Workforce Learning and engagement sessions delivered for a range of partners including PVI sector leaders, HMIE, Health Visitor and Child Health Commissioner Networks. Initial development of a SLC knowledge and skills matrix to support the EY workforce.
