GIRFEC *My World* resource: Improving Outcomes for Speech, Language and Communication (SLC) Development



Within the GIRFEC National Practice model, the My World Triangle is the main tool for assessing the current circumstances in a child or young person's world.

The GIRFEC My World Resource for SLC supports practitioners to focus on factors associated with better and poorer SLC outcomes within any local GIRFEC assessment.

The SLC My World resource also provides a framework for a conversation with an individual family focusing on existing strengths and identification of opportunities to further improve SLC outcomes.

Being able to communicate supports many aspects of child development and wellbeing, including learning, confidence, friendships and emotional regulation.



The people who look after me

can be empowered to responsively support early language and communication development within everyday activities and interactions that respond to individual needs and preferences.
