Key messages for early language and communication

Evidence tells us that early language and communication development is crucially supported by responsive interactions from pre-birth.

Chatting Together messages describe four key ways to respond to babies and children to nurture early language and communication development.

Chatting Together messages are evidence-based and shaped by parents and practitioners.

The messages respond to parent requests for early sharing of accessible and consistent advice by practitioners they trust.
