What is it?

The network aims to build connections and create a practical, collaborative forum that supports whole-system change, from pre-birth through the early years.

The network connects colleagues working in early language and communication across the system. It supports a joined-up, preventative approach to early language development through share learning, good practice, and evidence-informed approaches to prevention for early SLC concerns in the context of local and national priorities

It is open to everyone, from strategic decision-makers and service leads to practitioners working directly with children and families who want to make a difference
