Dear Parent/Carer

This last week has seen some warm weather. Where possible, rooms and social areas are well-ventilated. Water-coolers are positioned in social areas around the school. Please ensure your child brings a reusable water bottle if he/she wishes to drink water through the school day. Pupils are permitted to drink water in classes. They are not permitted to drink hot drinks, juices or fizzy drinks during learning in classrooms. We advise against fizzy drinks and energy drinks during lunch and break times, as research suggest that such drinks do not support health and wellbeing.

As always, we try to exercise discretion on the wearing of school uniform if temperatures rise or fall to uncomfortable levels. Given that it also rained on Thursday, it is sensible for pupils to come prepared for changes in the weather.

Whilst we allow pupils to remove blazers and ties (if necessary), we still require them to wear school uniform. Pupils should wear white shirts/blouses, trousers/skirts/black shorts (of appropriate length and school-style). Tight-fitting sports' shorts/hot-pants are not permitted.

SQA Exam Timetable 2024

Last week we shared the SQA 2024 Timetable with parents/carers and pupils. We have since been advised by SQA that there are errors in the timetable and that it is currently being amended. The errors related to Geography and Chemistry examinations.

Please discard previous timetable. As soon as the SQA has published a new version, we will issue this to parents/carers and pupils.

Reporting

As a result of consultation and feedback from stakeholders, we have decided to make some changes to the way we report pupil progress.

Pupils in S1-3 will now receive 3 tracking reports per year and pupils in S4-6 will receive 4 tracking reports per year.

These shorter, more regular reports should be clearer and allow more scope for reflection by pupils and parents/carers. As we will be indicating any progress concerns with the reports, this means we will no longer be sending out progress concern letters. Feedback suggested these letters were not always helpful. Where appropriate, parents/carers will be invited to telephone relevant staff for more information when their child is not making expected progress.

As we develop our use of Satchel One, pupils and their parents/carers will receive ongoing feedback on progress, behaviour and achievement.

We are also looking to include certificated recognition of achievement with reports, linked to our school values, as we progress our new reporting system.
