Respectful Relationships/Mobile Phone Use

We will be sending out a summary of the principles of our policy Respectful Behaviour Policy to parents/carers in January. Please note that we will also be revisiting our Mobile Device Policy as part of improving learning and behaviour in classes. This means that pupils not complying with policy will have phones removed and sent to the school office for safekeeping, Parents/carers will be informed of infringements. There has been much research to show that misuse of mobile devices have a detrimental effect on learning. We are also finding that junior pupils, in particular, are contacting parents/carers during lessons. As phones will not be permitted to be used in these classes, this means any child using phones in this way will have their phone removed.
