Dear Parent/Carer

Our National 5 Prelims have almost finished, and we have been impressed with how our pupils have approached them. These prelims are important in helping pupils prepare for SQA exams and enabling better pathways to a positive destination in the future. Those who have missed prelims will have the opportunity to sit missed exams on Tuesday 9 December after school in the Main Hall. Pupils who miss exams without valid medical exemptions are not awarded a grade and this will affect their SQA estimate. Similarly, those who are late are not permitted to enter the exam, in accordance with SQA guidelines.

We had a lovely family cooking event on Thursday evening. Thanks, once again, to Miss Hay and Miss Hyslop for giving up their time to host this. Families made soup and a sponge and were able to take the recipes home to try these out in their own kitchens.

Pupils Late to School

We are currently looking at strategies to reduce latecoming. A reminder that period 1 begins at 8.50 AM. Please ensure your child arrives in school on time. Latecoming is disruptive and has an impact on your child's learning, as well as the learning of others that are interrupted as a result.

From 6 January parents/carers of any pupil who is late in the morning (without valid reason) will receive an SMS message advising that their child will receive an after-school detention.

There will be a focus on each year group each week. As S3 has the highest rate of latecoming and absence, we will begin with that group on Tuesday 6 January. The focus will be as follows:

S3 – Week beginning 5 January

S2 – Week beginning 12 January

S4 – Week beginning 19 January

S1/S5/6 – Week beginning 26 January

Well done to our S5 pupils, who have the best attendance rate of all year groups. We are delighted that pupils recognise the link between attendance and achievement in school.

Please note that thresholds for attendance and latecoming must be met if your child wishes to participate in extra-curricular events and trips. If pupils are missing school (unless for valid reasons), we cannot permit them to miss even more learning by participating in events/activities which are not part of the usual school day.

We understand that some young people have been subject to winter illnesses and take account of any short or long-term health issues.



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Winter Weather
