

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 2026 - 2027

PRIORITY ONE

We aim to **raise** attainment for our most deprived 20% of pupils in S4-S6 by increasing the number and quality of qualifications they achieve

IMPACT

The attainment of our most deprived 20% of school leavers will be equal to, or better than, similar schools and will improve chances of a positive destination for almost all pupils.

PRIORITY TWO

We aim to **improve** achievements in literacy and numeracy for all pupils by delivering very good learning experiences that allow staff to confidently monitor and assess pupils' progress.

IMPACT

Almost all pupils will make very good progress in literacy and numeracy. Almost all pupils will be accredited with an appropriate literacy and numeracy qualification by the end of S4, improving chances of successful employment or further study.

PRIORITY THREE

We aim to **deliver** a more diverse curriculum to meet the needs of our pupils in S1-3. We will do this by continuing to deliver high-quality professional learning for staff and developing more partnerships with other educational providers.

IMPACT

All staff will deliver high-quality lessons that engage pupils and meet their needs. Almost all pupils will actively reflect on, and improve, their skills for life learning and work.

PRIORITY FOUR

We aim to **increase** opportunities for all pupils to be more actively involved in the life of the school community. We will recognise and celebrate pupils' achievements more regularly and in a variety of different ways.

IMPACT

All pupils will feel valued, will take part in activities in the school community and will confidently reflect on their achievements. Celebration of success will be embedded in the school's ethos and culture.
