Who is DYW Live for?

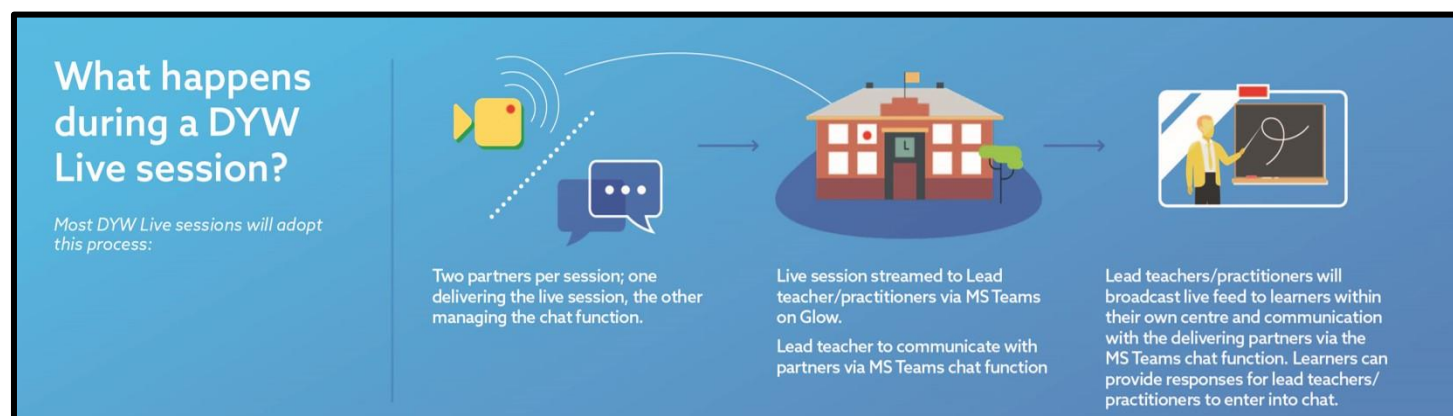

How does it work?

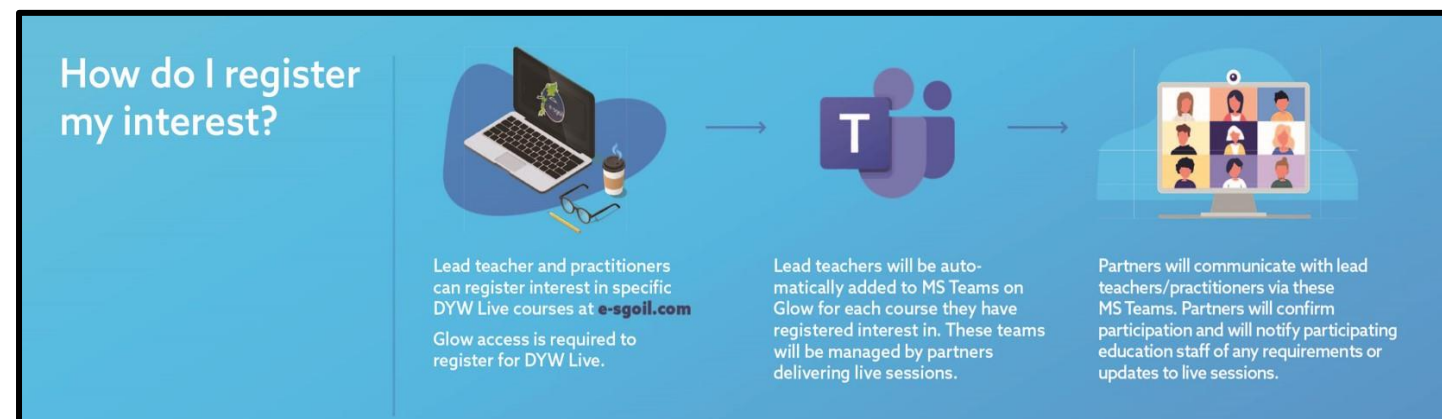
