


Volunteers' Week Scotland 2021 – Padlet Guide



When you are in the Padlet, click on the pink circle with the +





You then have 2 options.



In option 1 you type in the venue postcode and a digital pin will appear in your chosen location.





You then have the opportunity to add in more detail before your chosen location is saved.




Option 2, allows you to click and drag a pin to your chosen location.



You will again have the opportunity to add additional detail.



Don't worry about any pins posted in error. If you click on the pin you would like to delete the bin symbol will appear and you can easily delete it from the map.



The 3rd option is to tag our team into your post, or email us details of the event and we can ensure it's placed on the map on your behalf.
