

Child Protection Improvement Programme (CPIP)

Update from Celcis at Lead Officers Network on 1st November 2017

At the Lead Officers Network meeting on 1st November Celcis representatives provided a verbal update on the CPIP programme of work which they are supporting.

CPC Structures & Functions Questionnaire and Report

The report, and two presentations, based on the questionnaire sent to all CPCs was recently circulated. This report is seen as a baseline of the current position across Scotland. The draft went to the Minister and the Leadership group. The key area picked up was inconsistency across Scotland with questions asked regarding why there are such differences. Areas such as leadership and ownership, as well as what are the core components that make CPCs effective and well-functioning, are being considered.

Leadership Events

Regional events are starting to be planned. Two events. The Minister will chair and send out the invitations based on the information provided in the questionnaire regarding membership. The events will take place on Tuesday 16th January and Tuesday 23rd January 2018. Locations will be confirmed as soon as possible. Events will be half days (2 events on each day; one in the morning and one in the afternoon). It is hoped that, as far as possible, members of the same chief officers group will attend the same event.

ICRs/SCRS

Celcis are considering/scoping Rec 8 & 9 in terms of timescales and deliverables. They may join up with the work being done by Care Inspectorate regarding this area.

CPC data sets

Data set being looked at further based again on what came through questionnaire as outlined in the presentation. They are linking into the work being done in the neglect pilot areas. Looking at what's good and useful. They will also ensure this work is aligned with the Care Inspectorate given focus of future inspections, and the way they work in terms of intelligence and data collection. Interrogation and analysis seen as key areas. There will be further engagement around this area but no 'consultation'.
