

Child Protection in Forth Valley e-module

Forth Valley Child Protection Committees 'Child protection: an introduction' online training course.

Aim: to help practitioners and volunteers develop awareness and understanding of how to recognise, respond, report and record concerns about a child or young person who is or may be in need of protection and understand child protection processes.

Target Audience: practitioners and volunteers who are part of the *general workforce*. Those who as part of their job or role are likely to come into contact with children, young people and other family members. The frequency of contact will vary, but these workers will not usually be involved in any in depth personal work with them or directly involved at all. However these workers need to have the confidence and awareness to recognise when a child or young person may be in need of protection and how to respond.

The module will take 20-30 minutes to complete and can be worked through at your own pace. Included in the module are: teaching pages, reflective tasks, interactive learning activities and a knowledge check. After successful completion, a certificate is produced.
