C Hello Jeff. My name is CM. I'm a CO with FC as well. I am here to help Tom.

TB And before we start can I just show you my badge, my ID - please.

T I'm glad we could see you today J. The reason we came was that some staff, here on Wed, were worried about you. And a part of....

J Was that big Michael?

T Yes. Michael Bowd, the staff nurse. He phoned us + said he was a bit worried. And that's why we came, to give you a chance to talk.

J Well what is you want to know

T Can I just tell you J - that while we would like to talk to you, you don't have to speak if you don't want to. You have choices, to talk to us or not to speak at all.

Q. Well you are the social work. If you are OK with me I will always talk to people.

A. OK - That's good. But you can choose and if there is anything we ask about & you don't want to talk about it then OK - that's your choice.

Q. That's all fine with me pal.

A. Just couple of other things - Cathy here will take some notes - that's important. And also, after talking to you, it's a part of my job to go back & tell my boss what we talk about. Any one might talk to other people Jeff - people you know for, if we are worried about you, we might need to speak to the police.

Q. We are not needing the police, they are not going to help me.

A. OK. But in some situations it's part of my job to speak to them. I just needed to tell you that. Is there anything you want to ask us Jeff?

Q. Is this about my daughter. Is that what this is about?

A. Daughter, your daughter ... we would like to ask about it. ~~before~~ do you want to tell us about yourself

Q. Well, I'm done in. Old ad getting fed up with my chest & my inhaler never seems to work for me

any longer. Was the same for Ellen, I think your body gets used to the intake + it doesn't work as well.

T Ellen is your late wife...

J Age. She died in bed. Came in to get surgery but even before they operated she took worse and two days later she was gone. I never saw it coming. Never thought she wouldn't make it.

T And how have things been

J I took a long time to get used to it. Living on my own. At least I have Casper. My dog. He kept me sane. When you got to walk a dog, feel him it all helps. And my mate Mick's been great

T You mate?

J Know him for years. Not through football coaching. And he's been a good, good friend. Getting me out, to the football, to the pub. Just at the house. And he's been up here every day since I came in here. And he's got Casper for me

T You've been in hospital now for 4 days diff. How were things before?

J Until my chest was bad I was getting by. I am now not getting out the house. I've got a wee more coming in + she does all my

shopping + cleaning. And being honest she is now doing my cooking too. I asked Margaret to do some shopping but that never happened.

T And Margaret your daughter. Can you tell us about her.

J. Where do I start. We have had a tough time with her. Even when Ellen was here she was hard work

T "she"?

J Margaret. I suppose that nurse told you about it all

T Can you tell us

J. With Margaret it's all about money. Always will be. Money + Margaret as a bad mix. If we didn't handle it right you go then there's no chance now. It's never going to change

T What will change

J That she + Rob will have live on their own money. So they come to my door. And I try + say enough is enough. But I get. It's terrible

T Can you say more about it

J. £400 for a carpet. And £200 to get a new dishwasher. The she asked for £500 to let her go to the Kevin at his football in Blackpool - some kids tournament

T. And who is Kevin

J. My oldest grandson. Good at football + I paid for them all to go to Blackpool. Tried to say no. But Margaret never takes a no. She can't

T. What do you me

J. I don't know if you can help me - & it's really my problem, I am not sure talking you about it will help. And you people in social work will see much worse than me

T. You don't need to tell us anything Jeff. And I can't praise anything. But we will listen if you want to talk - and if we can help we can tell you how

J. Margaret just turns it on. She knows... she always knows how to hurt me. Get me to say yes. To give in. And she just does it. [Jeff wiped a tear in his eye - was visibly upset - shaking head]

T. Take your time Jeff

J. Maybe its me - she says I'm selfish and maybe I am. But now she wants to move in. She hates her ~~neighbours~~ neighbours. Says they make her life hell. And she is saying she wants Rob + her + the kids to move in with me. And if that happen I will never get Margaret back out. And I've tried, I've pleaded with her that I can't cope with them all - and she says if I don't let her she + Rob will split up - + it's all down to me. And she won't hesitate to tell the boys that their grandad, their selfish

grandad has caused their mum + dad to split up.
And nicks telling me not to give in. But I can't
do it. I'm always thinking maybe she's right. Maybe
she needs the house more than me. I don't know. And

ashamed that I'm not helping them out. [Jeff wiped tears
+ took glasses off].

two of them are decent boys. Good kids

I would like to speak to others too - Dr ~~St~~ Stevenson, Nick. If you agree we can get their views + ideas too. I'm worried you are at risk, that the law calls an adult at risk - and someone, just how who needs support + protection. It's a poor way of saying someone who needs help to keep everything OK + safe.
