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ADULT SUPPORT & PROTECTION (S) ACT 2007

- Applicable to **all** adults 16 years or over
- HSCP are responsible & accountable
- Personal, professional, service/ reputational risks
- Statutory responsibility

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THREE POINT TEST – All points to be evidenced and met.

In your opinion:

- Is the adult able to safeguard their own wellbeing, property, rights or other interests?
- Is the adult at risk of harm or self-harm
- Is the adult affected by disability, mental disorder, illness or physical or mental infirmity and more vulnerable than adults who are not so affected?

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DEVELOPMENTS

- Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) for related activities
- Procedures & efficiencies
- Legislation
- Care Inspectorate Thematic Inspections

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TIMESCALES

- Discuss with Team Manager immediately & in any case within one day
- IRD same day or in any case within three days
- Commence investigation within five days
- Conclude investigation within 20 days
- If risks still present then convene Case Conference
